PEOPLE FACTOR



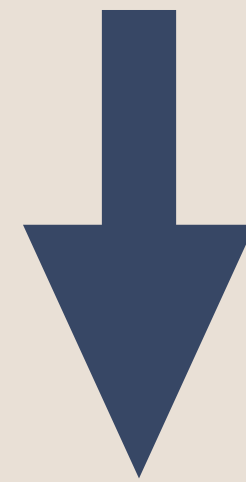

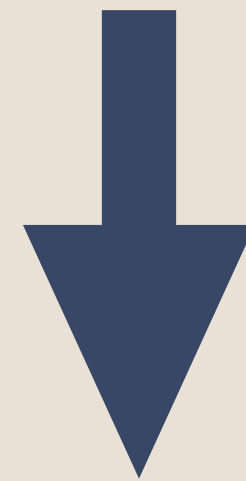
**You have an ABNORMAL need for
